Cycling in Bordeaux, France - 1 to 8 September 2018.

Our U3A cycling group are embarking on a boat/bike holiday in September in the Bordeaux area of France. The holiday is on a river boat with hired bikes on board, and varying distances (20-32 miles) are cycled daily to the next embarkation point. Cycling is not compulsory and there is an option to stay on board.

Walking Holiday in Freshwater Bay, Isle of Wight, - 30 April to 4 May 2019

A 4-night holiday with full board has been arranged at Freshwater Bay on the Isle of Wight, which is situated by the sea on the south side of the island. There will be a choice of 3 walks each day, with up to 7 miles on the easier walks, 9 miles on medium walks and 12½ miles on harder walks. There is also the option to take a Discovery Tour holiday, with gentle walks of up to 1½ miles and visits to local sites by minibus. You can also take a Country House break and organise your own time.

Cycling Holiday to Prague and Beyond 6th - 13th July 2019

The cycling group have arranged a river boat with bike hire from Prague next year, and as this is a larger boat than usual (the "Florentina") we are able to open this tour to all members of the U3A.

The cycling should be relatively easy along the rivers with reasonable distances. It is NOT limited to cyclists and one doesn't have to cycle at all, just stay on the boat. The price includes 7 breakfasts and 3 course dinners, plus 6 packed lunches or snack lunches for those who choose to stay on the boat. There is also tea/coffee on 6 afternoons after cycling. There is an on board tour guide who will give daily briefings on the cycle routes. Flights have not yet been arranged
